**SCHOOL CURRICULUM DESIGN**

**PRE-PRIMARY: LKG AND UKG**

1. **Curriculum:-** Though no systematically age-appropriate syllabus has been prescribed for LKG-UKG, teachers strictly adhere to the books as prescribed for these classes by the Society from time to time. They may also utilize the list of websites given in Education code 2020.

2. **Teaching Methodology:-** The emphasis given on Activity-Based Learning. The pre-primary classes follow the dictum of "No Home- Work-No Books-No Note books filled Bags". All books and notebooks for classes LKG and UKG are to be kept in the School itself, for which the School provides lockers. The entire teaching procedure has to involve the following:-

- (a) Two class activities for each concept taught.
- (b) Organizing one trip a month to various outdoor places.
- (c) In-house publication of monthly Newsletter outlining the activities conducted.
- (d) Celebrating days of national and international importance.
- (e) Visits by parents for taking guest classes once a month.
- (f) Using variety of Educational aids for teaching.
- (g) Conducting Circle Time for four days a week in which children sit in a circle with the teacher, at any place outside their classrooms, at the beginning of the day, with each child being given the opportunity to tell a story.
- (h) Making monthly Activity Calendar based on the theme for the month.
- (i) Making each class responsible for conducting Theme Assembly Programmes every Friday on a rotation basis.
- (j) Setting up separate Word Walls in the classroom for English and Hindi words.
- (k) Displaying Bulletin Boards inside the classroom at the height of the child with picture based information.
- (l) Displaying Theme of the Month Boards outside the classroom.
- (m) Making Activity Folders for each student for filing the completed and corrected worksheets.
- (n) Organizing one class competition and one Cooperative Game every day.

3. **Observation of Teachers:-** For ensuring implementation, observation of teachers in class the HM supervise the teachers once a month using checklist given in the Education Code. He/She is bring out the weaknesses and strengths of the teachers and endorse the same in his/her counselling register.

4. **Assessment and Feedback:-** The children have to be assessed twice a year. This assessment is strictly on the developmental aspects.

5. **Feedback to Parents:-** Our School provide feedback to parents at every stage of learning. The school give:-

(a) Monthly calendars that brief about the activities planned in the School for the month.

(b) Monthly Newsletters covering the activities carried out in the previous month.

(c) Inviting Parent Volunteers once a month.

6. **Text Books:-** Only the text books prescribed by the Society are used for the pre-primary classes.

### CLASSES 1 AND ABOVE

7. **Syllabus:-** The school offers a course of studies that prepare the students to take the Secondary/Senior School Examination of CBSE as per the syllabi of the Board. Text Books are specified by the Society.

8. **Medium of Instruction:-** The medium of instruction in the school is English.

9. **Home Assignments:-** As a general principle, home work/assignment is avoided for classes I to V. Home work/assignment is resorted only under unavoidable circumstances and are given to the students in such a manner that it does not cause any undue stress/tension in their minds.

10. **Examination:-**

(i) Eight cycle assessment for class I-II. CA 1- May, CA2- July, CA3- August, CA4- Sep, CA5 Nov, CA6 Dec, CA7- Jan, CA8- March.

(ii) Two periodic assessments, one half yearly and one annual for class III-V.

PA1- July, Half Yearly Sep-Oct, PA 2- Dec, Annual Exam-March



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
