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INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ALL POSTS

18. For all posts mentioned above except Accounts Assistant, Clerk and Helpers, candidates to be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2024.

19. For posts of Accounts Assistant and Clerk, candidates to be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July 2024.

20. Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

21. Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

22. Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

23. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except PRT (Games), PRT (Drawing), Helpers).

24. All shortlisted applicants will be informed telephonically about the Written Test and interview at Air Force School Chabua tentatively on **22 Feb 24**. Candidates arriving late will not be permitted. Original copies of certificates will be required to be brought by the candidate for verification.

25. The posts mentioned above are of **Non-governmental**. All the dates and venue are tentative and are subject to change. As the advertisement is published to draw a panel and fill up vacancies on requirement, it does not guarantee compulsory employment in any capacity in the school.

Completed applications in all respects along with photocopies of relevant certificates and testimonials in sealed envelope superscribed with the name of the post applied for, are to reach AF School Chabua by ordinary post only or dropped in the Drop Box kept at Main Gate of Air Force Station Chabua on all working days by 1400h. Last date for submission of application form is **20 Feb 24**. **NO APPLICATION WILL BE ENTERTAINED THEREAFTER.**

27. Candidates are advised to bring their own stationery and writing material, for the test. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the test and subsequent selection procedure, if any.
